Fairfields Opening Plan: COVID-19
Date of Opening: Saturday, July 4, 2020

Please Note: This plan is subject to change, based on direction from provincial and/or city governments.

ACCESS TO THE POOL

- Only members with prearranged swim bookings will be permitted onto the pool deck area.
- Members who wish to drop-in for a swim, must line up outside of the pool deck area in the designated waiting area. Members are to adhere to the physical distancing markings and signage.
- Members are not to be congregating on the property.
- The pool is only open to Members, no guests are permitted on the property at this time.
- All members are to complete a COVID-19 Member Waiver and Declaration.
 - This can be printed at home and brought to the pool or copies are available at the pool for members to complete.
- Members or a person residing within a Member's household must not have returned from any other province or country outside of Ontario within the past 14 days. Members will not visit the pool for 14 days from the date of return to Ontario.
- Members must not have a fever, cough, sore throat, respiratory illness, difficulty breathing or flu like symptoms or have not been in contact with or reside with someone who has these symptoms. Members will be required to remain away from the pool for 14 days commencing at the completion of the symptoms.
- All members are encouraged to conduct and pass a self-assessment each day prior to coming to the pool to confirm that they are symptom free. Link to self-assess:

- Before members are permitted into the pool area, they will have their temperature taken and will be asked the following questions:
 1. Do you have any of the following symptoms?
 - New or worsening cough
 - Difficulty breathing
 - Fever or feeling feverish

2. Have you had close contact with a confirmed or probable case of Covid – 19
3. Are you awaiting test results for Covid – 19 because you have potentially been exposed?
4. Have you travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days?
5. Have you been in contact with someone who is ill and who has travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days?

FACILITY USAGE RULES

- Members are expected to adhere to all physical distancing signage.
- Members are encouraged to wear PPE when entering the facility or on deck.
- Members will enter the pool from the main entrance gate.
- The bike racks are still open for use but have been relocated to the north end of the parking lot.
- Members will exit the pool from the side yard gate.
- Pool office will be closed to all members. Entry only for pool staff members.
- Upon entering the pool, members are expected to sanitize their hands at one of the hand sanitizing stations.
- Members are encouraged to arrive at the pool showered, dressed and ready to swim.
- Only the main swimming pool will be open for swimming.
- The small kiddie/wading pool is closed.
- The side yard/grass area is closed.
- Washrooms/change rooms are open.
- Due to the size of the washrooms/change rooms, only one family is permitted in each washroom/change room at a time.
- Washrooms/change rooms will be cleaned after each use.
- The pool will be divided up into separate swim areas to allow for appropriate physical distancing between families.
- When members arrive, they are asked to find an area on the pool deck away from other families to set up any chairs and put down their belongings.
 - When not in the pool, members are asked to remain in their designated area.
 - Members are asked to keep all of their belongings in their designated area for the duration of their pool visit.
- Deck chairs will be available for members. Members who choose to use a deck chair(s) can pick a chair from the 'Clean' chair stack and take it to their designated area to use while at the pool.
- When leaving the pool, members are expected to take any deck chairs they used to the 'To Be Sanitized' area so the chairs can be properly sanitized before the next use.
- Members are encouraged to bring their own chairs to the pool to use. Chairs must not be left at the pool.
- No snorkels are permitted in the pool.
- No pool toys will be provided by Fairfields.

- At the discretion of the lifeguards on duty, members may be permitted to bring their own personal pool toys to use. No pool noodles are permitted.
- Life jackets are available for use. Members who choose to use a life jacket can pick up from the 'Clean' zone.
- When leaving the pool, members are expected to take any life jackets to the 'To Be Sanitized' area so the life jackets can be properly sanitized before the next use.
- Only plastic water bottles are permitted on the pool deck.
- Members are expected to remove all personal items and any garbage when leaving the pool.

PROGRAMMING

- There are no swimming lessons or programming at this time.
- The pool is open for Family Swim and Adult swim only.

HOW TO RESERVE A SWIM TIME

- Members are to call the pool at **905-916-1082** to reserve a 1 hour swim time.
- Reservations can be made up to 24 hours in advance.
- The phone line is open for reservations during pool hours only.
- At this time, members may only reserve one swim time per day.
- No reservations will be accepted by voicemail.
- Four swim lanes will be used for reservations and one swim lane will be used for drop-in.
- Members who wish to drop-in for a swim, must line up outside of the pool deck area in the designated waiting area. Members will be permitted to enter the pool if the pool is not at capacity.
- If you have not arrived at the pool within 15 minutes of your reserved swim time, your time may be given to any members waiting in the drop in line.
- Swim reservations are for 1 hour in length. Please note that this means members have one hour to swim and be on the pool deck.
 - Members will be asked to exit the pool 10 minutes before their end time in order to change and tidy up their deck area and exit the premises by the end of their hour.
